Cost	Free	1-year donation of \$30, 2 \$50, 3 \$70, lifetime membership for \$90
Class Schedule	3 sessions a year (Jan-Feb, May-Jun, Sep-Oct) 8 Weeks & 2 classes a week (same days each week)	Carousels always running and jump in anytime
Class Size	6 students, 1 Advisor and 1 Associate Advisor	Many instructors, Many classes per week
Format	Zoom, paddle keys, 60 minutes of practice a day	Zoom, Straight key preferred, Morse Practice page used class and practice, regular short amounts of practice
Class Levels	Beginner – no experience -> 6WPM Fundamental – 6WPM -> 10WPM Intermediate – Contests, DX, Ragchew 20wpm Advanced – Speed! 30wpm	BC1 – 18 chars; BC2 - 26 Chars & Prosigns; BC3 – Protocol/Exchanges INT1 - not losing focus; INT2 – Speed; INT3 – Word comprehension

TIPS

DON'T USE A CHEAT SHEET

AVOID USING A DECODER

DON'T COUNT DITS AND DAHS – HEAR THE LETTER AS A SOUND. HIGHER SPEEDS CAN PROMOTE THIS - *“It is NOT THE SPEED AT WHICH A LETTER IS SOUNDED THAT PERPLEXES THE LEARNER, BUT THE RAPID SUCCESSION IN WHICH THEY FOLLOW EACH OTHER.” (USE EFFECTIVE SPEED 25/8, 25/10...)*

SENDING WILL IMPROVE YOUR COPYING

CODE TALK TO PRACTICE – THE LICENSE PLATE EXAMPLE

CW ADVANTAGES
